EXAMPLES OF SERVICES PERFORMED BY FIXIT CORPS VOLUNTEERS

Plumbing

- Repair leaking faucets
- Replace washers
- Replace float in toilet tank
- Repair toilet valve

Carpentry

- Install bathroom grab bars
- Install or replace handrails
- Replace porch steps
- Replace rotted deck boards
- Repair door locks
- Install weather-stripping
- Replace storm/screen doors

Electrical

- Repair switches, outlets or sockets
- Repair light fixtures
- Replace cords/plugs on lamps
- Replace light bulbs
- Replace batteries in smoke alarms
- Repair small appliances
- Replace belts in vacuum cleaners

Painting

- Priming and painting of windows and door trim, doors & thresholds

What is the Fixit Corps?

The Fixit Corps is a program assisting seniors (60 years and older) or disabled homeowners with minor home repairs and maintenance.



What is a minor home repair?

A minor repair is defined as a service requiring 5 hours or less to complete.

How is the service provided?

Homeowners requesting service call the RSVP office and explain the work needed. A qualified volunteer is assigned to the service and contacts the homeowner directly to schedule a time to visit. The homeowner is responsible for supplying all materials needed to complete the service. There is no fee for the labor provided by the Fixit Corps volunteer; however, donations are encouraged to sustain the program.

Who is eligible?

Any senior and/or disabled homeowner may call for assistance. There are no income requirements; however, priority is given to those who lack financial and/or physical resources to complete the service on their own.

Fees and Contributions

Labor is provided for free; however, donations are Accepted to support the costs to maintain the program.



Fixit Corps volunteers are not permitted to perform services that require the use of a ladder and/or services related to the sale, pending and/or planned sale of a home, or services in apartment buildings.
